Fellowship / Assistant UE Internship

Training allowing specialist practitioners to follow additional "fellowship" training in their specialty or discipline.

Conditions

- These trainees are specialist doctors who are nationals of a European Union (EU) Member State, a State party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area or Switzerland, and who hold a specialist diploma allowing them to practice the specialty effectively and lawfully in their country of origin.
- Institut Curie can welcome fellowships for hospital internships as well as fellowships for clinical research internships.
- Candidates have the status of Head of Clinic or Assistant in their country of origin.
- The status of reception and practice at the Institut Curie is "Fellowship".
- The training program is determined based on content: practical training at the Institut Curie. Candidates also have the possibility of further training at the university.
- Registration with the Departmental Council of the Order of Physicians ("Ordre des Médecins de Paris") is mandatory (minimum 6 months) in order to be entitled to practice medical acts and to obtain the RPPS number:

Duration of the formation

- The duration of training varies according to the scholarship/funding provided by the originating hospital/funding organization.

Level of language

- Proof of knowledge of the French language equivalent to level B2 (TCF, TEF, DELF) is required for candidates for an internship at the Hospital complex.
- For candidates in clinical research internship a proof of French language skills equivalent to level B2 is not required but English language is mandatory.

Financing

- The financing of the internship is specified in the tripartite internship agreement or employment contract.

How to apply



- Candidates must complete the registration form on the Institut Curie's training website and attach the documents requested for the analysis of their application.
