

OBSERVATION Internship

Conditions

- Observers can be practitioners who have already graduated, medical interns or medical students from the **European Union** (EU) or **Non-European Union nationals** (Non-EU).
- These trainees must not take part in any activity in the clinical or medico-technical structure and may not perform any medical acts, including by delegation.
- The program will be drawn up by the "maître de stage", i.e. the head of department/host department.

Language level

- The level of French must be sufficient for the objectives of the course.
- English is required.

Duration of the course

- The duration of an internship under observation is a maximum of **3 months**, renewal is possible.

Funding

- Since January 1, 2020 management fees have been applied to this type of course. These management costs may be covered by the candidate's home organisation, by a third party funding organisation or by the candidate him/herself.
- This internship is not remunerated by the Institut Curie.

Visa

- **For Non-EU applicants**, the Training Unit will draw up a letter of acceptance/invitation with the accepted internship period and signed by the Head of Department/Host Office. The trainee will have to take the necessary steps to obtain his/her visa.

To apply for a job

- Candidates must complete the registration form on the Institut Curie's training website and attach the documents requested for the analysis of their application.
