# Fellowship / Assistant Non-European Union

(decree of 22 November 2017(

#### **Conditions**

- Candidates are specialist doctors from outside the European Union, who hold a specialty diploma allowing them to practice this specialty effectively and lawfully in their country of origin.
- The application for a traineeship must be made within the framework of a partnership either between their country of origin and France, or between their practice establishment and the Institut Curie.
- The Curie Institute submits the application for temporary authorization to practice to the National Centre for the Management of Hospital Practitioners (CNG: www.cng.santé.fr).
- The temporary authorization to practice issued by the Ministry of Health allows the above-mentioned professionals to work at the Curie Institute for a given period of time in order to follow a complementary "fellowship" training course in a department / service approved by the Regional Health Agency (ARS) for the training of interns in the specialty.
- Determined based on content: practical training at the Institut Curie and the possibility of further training at the relevant French university.
- They have the status of full-time "**fellowship**" Specialist Assistant Practitioner on a fixed-term contract.
- Institut Curie can welcome fellowships for hospital internships as well as fellowships for clinical research internships.

#### **Duration of internship**

- This training cannot be less than 3 months or more than 2 years.

### Language level

- Proof of a diploma of knowledge of the French language equivalent to level B2 (TCF, TEF, DELF).

or

A certificate issued by the Institut Curie stating that the specialist practitioner will carry
out his or her duties without contact with patients and without participating in the
continuity of care, within the framework of research activities.



## **Funding**

- The training is paid for either by the institution of origin or by a third party, or by the Institut Curie.

#### Visa

- Long-stay visa equivalent to a residence permit (VLS-TS) or temporary residence permit for practitioners who will be paid by the Curie Institute.
- VLS-TS "trainee" for specialist practitioners who will be paid by the home institution.

# To apply for a job

- The decree of 22 November 2017 and the order of 19 March 2018 provide for the possibility of issuing a temporary authorization to practice in France to doctors holding a specialist's diploma allowing them to practice this specialty effectively and lawfully in their country of origin.
- Candidates must complete the registration form on the Institut Curie's training website and attach the documents requested for the analysis of their application.
